

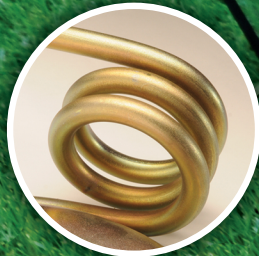
# AN *Industry* FAVORITE

Homecrest invented and patented the "original" swivel rocker mechanism in 1956. New collections today are still using the swivel rocker mechanism making it an industry favorite.



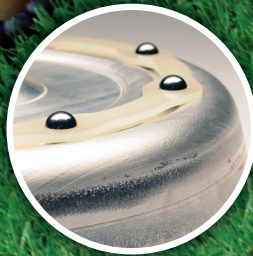
## Top Swivel Plate

The top swivel plate is electroplated with zinc prior to painting. This adds protection to the welded surfaces from outdoor elements.



## Triple Coil

The triple coil consists of three springs for superior durability and a smooth rock.



## Ball Bearings

The stainless steel ball bearings are on a nylon race and are placed between two swivel plates to provide a smooth swivel action.



## Comfort Adjustment

Tension setting adjustments are located on the undercarriage and allows the right rocking motion for each individual.
